



Good Morning,

Nearing the half way mark of the grass trial and the steers continue to do well, particularly after two falls of 20mm and 25mm throughout March on the trial paddock.

First of the Faecal NIRS reports have arrived, as attached, displaying favourable weight gain conditions. Most interesting is the high(37.66%) non-grass diet in a buffel paddock. I would attribute this to left over herbage that are evident on the Western end of the paddock, copper burr, gidyea burr, pigweed, salt bush and red burr. Faecal analysis will be carried out fortnightly to monitor change.
